Subject: Kern River - Fillmore Compressor Station Force Majeure

Notice Text:

Kern River hereby provides notice of a force majeure effective April 15, 2019, due to an unexpected pipe repair at the Fillmore compressor station. The Fillmore station will be unavailable for the duration of the repair. Kern River does not currently have an estimated return to service date, but will provide updates as new information becomes available.

The operating capacity at Fillmore compressor station will be used to evaluate nominations downstream of Fillmore during the repair. Beginning gas day April 15, 2019 Intraday 3 cycle and gas day April 16, 2019 Evening cycle, the Fillmore operating capacity will be reduced from 2,476,000 Dth to 1,995,000 Dth. The system operating capacity will be evaluated each cycle to ensure throughput is maximized. Kern River does not anticipate that primary firm transportation will be impacted based on recent nomination patterns; however, this is subject to change based on actual nominations/confirmations. Kern River anticipates that secondary firm and interruptible transportation may be impacted.

Displayed below for reference are the total scheduled nominations and the total primary firm scheduled nominations during gas day April 16, 2019, Timely cycle.
